<Selection Criteria>

Selections will be based on student's overall academic progress, records of past studies, study plan, personal statement, other achievement records and financial needs by each college.

<Accommodation>

Applicants have the option of living on campus at the Gwanak-sa dormitory and Yongon dormitory. Applications for accommodation should be directed to the relevant dormitory office during the student selection period. Applicants should apply online at the Gwanak-sa homepage at <http://dorm.snu.ac.kr> or the Yongon dormitory homepage at <http://snudorm.clubmd.net>.

(c) Students who applied for the designated departments which participate with GSFS Program for Fall 2020. See <Number of Selections> for information on designated departments.

<Renewal of Scholarship >

- (a) Scholarship may be renewed on an academic semester basis; the recipients must maintain an average grade point level of 3.0/4.3.
(b) Please note that the recipients of GSFS Program might be restricted of taking leave of absence. For leave of absence, recipients should contact OIA and the office of representative college office.
