Why Should We Get A Flu Vaccine Every Year?

A new flu vaccine is made each year because flu viruses are changing every year. Getting a flu shot EVERY year is highly recommended.

I Am Healthy and Young. Should I Get A Shot ?

Even healthy people can get a flu, and it can be serious.

Everyone 6 months and older should get a flu vaccine. This means you!

✓ We serve **Cell-Cultured Influenza Vaccines** this year !

✓ Choose what you prefer between **Trivalent and Quadrivalent vaccines!!**

- **Cell-cultured vaccine** a newly developed vaccine instead of egg-based vaccine.
Person with egg-allergy can get a cell-cultured vaccine without risk of allergic reaction!
- **Trivalent vaccine** Prevention for 3 types of influenza viruses (2 A and 1 B)
- **Quadrivalent vaccine** Prevention for 4 types of influenza viruses (2 A and 2 B)
- ❖ **Although quadrivalent vaccines are designed to provide broader protection against influenza viruses, data directly comparing effectiveness of trivalent versus quadrivalent vaccines are not available.**

Who SHOULD get vaccinated against flu?

- Children over 6 months to 5 years of age
- Adults over 50 years
- People taking care of kids under 6 months
- People living with adults over 50 years
- Women who are or will be pregnant
- Person who have immunosuppression and their family members
- Patients with diabetes, chronic pulmonary diseases (including asthma), heart diseases (except isolated hypertension), liver, kidney, neurologic, hematologic, or metabolic disorders
- Children and adolescents who are receiving long-term aspirin therapy
- Health care providers
